POSTER CONTEST

The Burnaby Together – Coalition Against Racism and Hate work with member organizations in the community to develop projects to promote multiculturalism, address racism and discrimination to make Burnaby become a more inclusive and welcome community.

Background:

- Burnaby is one of the most diverse cities in Canada, where 51% of the residents are not Canadian born and visible minorities accounted for close to two thirds (63.6%) of Burnaby's total population. With a large number of refugees and immigrants settling in Burnaby also come misunderstandings stereotypes and challenges of insecurity.
- To eliminate racism, discrimination and avoid incidents of hate - the commitment from all sectors of society is needed. It requires Community members to take the responsibility to stand up against hate and racism and be morally obliged to report incidents. We all have different perspectives and come from different backgrounds and we are more than what we see. We have more in common. We all have families, life expectations, career ambitions, similar lifestyles, attend educational institutions and enjoy life.

Therefore, Burnaby Together – Coalition Against Racism and Hate would like to involve youth by creating a poster that can be used to spread awareness to our local communities about discrimination and hate.

Topic: Inclusion, discrimination, hate, racism and diversity

Entry period: **November 1, 2018– January 31, 2019**

Eligibility: You must be a high-school student attending any secondary school in Burnaby

Guidelines: This is a poster contest that can feature a single person or a group of people using a photo image Each image should highlight diversity, acceptance, tolerance and values of different races, ethnicities, sexual orientation, age and disabilities (love, gay, young, immigrant, living with a disability, etc.). Photographs must be in high resolution. Photo consent of person or people in the photograph included in the Entry form must be signed. Entries must have relevance to the themes of anti-racism, discrimination, hate and diversity.

Theme: The title for your poster will be ***"I live in Burnaby and I am _____"***. The "I am" can be left up to you but should include aspects of a person in **terms of personality traits, career ambitions, hobbies, lifestyle and love of family that we all have.**

Submissions of entries: By email to Nicole Hurtubise at ea@burnabyfamilylife.org. The selected pictures will be used for a poster campaign against racism, discrimination and hate in Burnaby.

Prizes: The top three selections will receive \$50 and the winning participants will be announced at a special ceremony to celebrate the International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination on March 20th, 2019.
